

in terms of facilitating the conduct of its Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination(UTME).

The Registrar, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, stated this when he paid a courtesy visit to the Nigerian High Commission in The Gambia. He pointed out that the purpose of the courtesy visit was to seek the cooperation of the High Commission in the registration and conduct of examination for prospective candidates. He requested that the High Commissioner nominate a Desk Officer in the Commission to assist in the registration of candidates at the High Commission.

Prof. Oloyede explained that the registration fee is \$20 or its equivalent while all other logistics would be worked out with the Director, Test Administration, and the Desk Officer along with the representative of the Centre where the examination would be

conducted.

The Registrar expressed appreciation for the warm reception accorded him and his entourage by the High Commissioner and briefed him about the mission, vision and the roles of JAMB in terms of facilitating the placement of students in the diaspora in Nigerian Universities.

According to the Registrar, some private universities are also partnering with JAMB to ensure that in case of any crisis in the public universities, these foreign students would be accommodated by these institutions to ensure that they enjoy a smooth academic experience in Nigeria.

His Excellency, the High Commissioner, Mr. Mohammed Manu, in his remarks, welcomed the Registrar and his delegation to the High Commission. He expressed happiness for being a part of the JAMB initiative aimed at providing opportunities for Nigerian students in the

diaspora as well as Gambian nationals, who are desirous of pursuing their education in Nigeria. He promised to give the gesture wide publication in the country.

PUNCH NEWSPAPER SATURDAY JANUARY 14TH 2023 - FG Seeks Partnership on Access to Education: The Federal Government has declared that the lingering number of out-of-school children is inimical to the economic growth and advancement of Nigeria.

The Minister of State for Education, Goodluck Nanah, who disclosed this at the commencement of the campaign for out-of-school children in Abeokuta, Ogun State, urged state governors and stakeholders to intensify the effort to eradicate the menace.

He said, "We must always remember that education is our collective responsibility and its failure can well be taken as the failure of us all. This calls for the need for all hands to be on the deck."

VANGUARD NEWSPAPER MONDAY JANUARY 16TH 2023 - JAMB's Lonely Road To Federalism: Mr Lakemfa, a columnist said in his piece that a country wracked with corruption and impunity, cannot but be confronted by examination malpractices and admission rackets even by institutions. This was the conclusion he reached at the end of the January 8, 2023 Stakeholders Meeting between the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board, JAMB. and media executives.

Another conclusion was that no matter how degenerate things become, we must never be short of men and women determined to fight the scourge. "JAMB Registrar, Professor Is-haq Olarewaju Oloyede narrated stories of the Board's unending battles with fraudsters who try to beat the system.

He said for example, during the 2022 UTME/DE registration, some cartels collected N200, 000 from candidates who they promised to offer assistance to score at least 300 marks in the examinations. Having been tipped off about these cartels, JAMB allowed all the candidates to register and sit for the examination.

"Their results were then withheld and for two months, none of the candidates protested. Then it decided to play a mind game with the candidates; it invited all of them to re-write the examination."But the cartels sabotaged the attempt by ensuring the systems broke down at the centre, so the examination could not be conducted.

As part of counter measures, the Registrar said the Board in 2023 would not release results of candidates who are exempted from biometric verification until same have been subjected to proper scruting.

The examination body had in 2017 introduced the Central Admissions Processing System, (CAPS), to automate admission into all tertiary institutions in the country, but many of the institutions simply bypassed it. Oloyedeinformed that the Federal Government has granted a waiver to enable JAMB process retroactive admission letters to the affected students after careful verification of the minimum requirements for admissions into the tertiary institutions.

To check the fraudulent issuance of Advance Level results, the Board, he said, is putting in place a Validation Process built on functional database, and only results in the Databank can be used for Direct Entry into universities. JAMB also introduced an electronic system (Autobot) which provides Artificial Intelligence on the capacity of every CBT Centre, simulates real-time examination condition and helps in Pre-Accreditation Assessment.

In trying to devolve more powers to the tertiary institutions JAMB is finding creative legal means of financially supporting the institutions while encouraging healthy competition amongst them. For instance, it has a running Corporate Social Responsibility component called the National Tertiary Admissions Performance Merit Award, NATAP-M.

It is in five categories with each category attracting N100 million. The amount of N75m goes to the winner, N15m to first runner-up and N10m to the second. Professor Oloyede at the forum announced the increase of the prize money to N750m. To ensure it goes round, winning institutions cannot win the prize until five years later.

the 2023 examinations, the UTME/DE application fee will be N3, 500. The Board also noted that N500 would be paid for the reading text; the sum to be charged by CBT centres would be N1, 700 for those who do not opt for the mock UTME, while the CBT service charge for those who opted for the mock would be N2, 700.

In addition, a total of N700 would be paid as a registration centre service charge and N1, 000 as an examination centre service charge.

In all, the Board noted that the grand total without mock would be N5, 700; with mock, N6, 700 and N4, 700 for Direct Entry applicants.

DAILYSUN NEWSPAPER TUESDAY JANUARY 17TH 2023 - Sale of UTME Forms: JAMB Warns Financial Institutions Against Extortion: The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has warned financial institutions participating in the sale of its application documents for the 2023 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) against extortion of candidates. The Board stated that only its accredited financial institutions would be allowed to vend its e-PINs.

The Registrar, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, at a session with financial institutions recently, stated that all participating vendors/tellers must indicate interest and register with the Board for ease of

identification and record keeping.

While thanking the financial institutions for their support to the JAMB over the years, he said their timely and priceless ideas and suggestions have helped to drastically reduce the financial burden of its transactions and transformed the financial processes of the Board to one that is in tune with modern dictates.

Oloyede admonished vendors to be upright in their dealings with the aspiring UTME/DE candidates so as not to run foul of its extant rules of engagement. The Registrar, while explaining the seamless payment process, said each candidate must have obtained the National Identification Number (NIN) as that is the gateway to the registration because the candidates would first create a profile by sending their NIN, followed by a space, then the eleven-digit number (NIN) to 55019 or 66019. TRIBUNE NEWSPAPER WEDNESDAY JANUARY 18TH 2023 - LAUTECH, IBB Varsity Researchers Win TETFundGrants: A team of four researchers from the LadokeAkintola University of Technology (LAUTECH), Ogbomoso, Oyo State, has won N89.1 million as research grant from the Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETFund), under the 2021 TETFund National Research Fund (NRF)

Intervention.

This was contained in a statement made available to The Nigerian Tribune on Monday by the public relations officer of the institution, Mr. Lekan Fadeyi.

While the acting Vice-Chancellor of LAUTECH, Professor Mojeed Olaide Liasu, lauded the scholars for their efforts in winning the grants, the Registrar of the institution, DrKayode Ogunleye, appreciated them for their contributions to the awards that had added to the laurels of the university.

Earlier, the Director of LAUTECH Centre of Research, Innovation and Development (LAUCRID), Professor TaofikAdedosu, in his remark had commended the Management of the University for its support, which he said had enabled the centre to excel.

In another development, some researchers from the Niger State-owned Ibrahim Badamasi Babangida University Lapai (IBBUL) have won grants from the Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETfund) under the National Research Fund (NRF) intervention.

The research grant which is to the tune of over N70 million was won by three teams with Professors Musa Dickson Achimugu, Dadi-Mamud Naomi John and Dr Yusuf Ishaqas principal researchers.

LEADERSHIP NEWSPAPER SATURDAY, 21<sup>st</sup> JANUARY, 2023—WAEC Sanctions 13 Secondary Schools Over Exams Malpractice: The West African Examinations Council (WAEC) has sanctioned 13 Secondary Schools in Gombe State over cases of examination malpractice.

The Director of examinations in the Gombe State Ministry of Education, Ali Yaya, disclosed this during a meeting with principals of secondary schools in the state.

He said the development was a major setback in the ministry's effort to improve the education sector in the state as it had led to the de-recognition of seven public schools in the state between 2018 and 2020 by WAEC and in 2022, six schools caught have been de-recognoised by WAEC and fine with a N500,000 penalty.

According to the him, examination malpractice is currently the major challenge facing senior secondary schools in the state, and the menace must be tackled before it escalates to other schools.

He warned schools to avoid malpractice of any forms, adding that any school found wanting again would be seriously punished.

rescheduled for other available sessions. It added that the affected candidates would be required to wait at their centre to receive official communication from the Board's National Headquarters, Abuja, as to when their lost session would be rescheduled.

The statement reads in parts,

"Candidates would be notified of their new scheduled centre before they leave the examination centre. Furthermore, no candidate is allowed to spend less than one hour before submission during his/her examination."

The Board observed that late commencement of examination or early

departure from examination hall could jeopardise the conduct of the examination by giving some candidates undue advantage over their contemporaries taking the examination. The Board stated that the new advisories are to ensure a level playing field for all candidates taking the examination.

# JUSTIFY YOUR PARENTS INVESTMENTS IN YOU, OLOYEDE CHARGES FUOYE'S FRESH STUDENTS

call has gone to the seven thousand, three hundred new intakes of the Federal University, Oye-Ekiti, Ekiti State, to justify their parents' huge investments in their education.

This charge was given by the Registrar of the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB), Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, at the sidelines of the 12th Matriculation Ceremony of the University, which was held on Friday, 13th January, 2023.

Prof. Oloyede, who was represented at the event by the Ag. Coordinator of the Ekiti State Office of the Board, Mr. Ebenezer Owolafe, urged the students to stay focused and shun anti-social activities that could derail their primary objective at the institution as they have to justify their parents' confidence and huge investments in them.

Speaking with JAMBulletin at the venue of the ceremony, the Registrar said, "It is not enough to get matriculated in an institution, because many get matriculated but never graduated not for reasons attributed to acts of God but through peer pressure, indolence, cultism, incessant partying and clubbing, excessive religious activities, students' unionism, among others."

"The only way a child sent to school by a parent can make such parent happy and fulfilled is for the child to concentrate on his studies, and graduate not only with good grade but also with good character and learning."

In his address on the occasion, the Vice Chancellor of the University, Prof. Abayomi Fasina, attributed the success story of the institution to hardwork and discipline, adding that based on the statistics from JAMB, FUOYE was one of the most-subscribed institution in Nigeria in 2022, noting that such an achievement was unexpected given the short period of the establishment of the University.

The Vice Chancellor admonished the newly-matriculated students to distance themselves from all acts inimical to the image of the University as well as their families, stressing that the Senate of the Institution would not hesitate to sanction any act capable of tarnishing the good reputation of the University.

He, therefore, urged the matriculating students to focus on their studies and shun all unwholesome activities capable of bringing the name of the school to disrepute.

### ...THE GAMBIA 2023: AWAU, An Opportunity For West African Universities to Restrategise on Education Impact

Association of West African Universities (AWAU) in Banjul, The Gambia, with the theme: "Repositioning Higher Education in West Africa for the 21st Century: Challenges and Opportunities."

According to him, the conference is an opportunity to take stock of our performance, reflect on its achievements, identify its challenges, map out opportunities to deepen its contributions in teaching, research and application of knowledge to solve problems in Africa.

While declaring the conference open, the Special Guest of Honour, the Minister of Higher Education, The Gambia, Prof. Pierre Gomez, represented by Mr. Muktar Darboe, the Deputy Permanent Secretary, Technical, said there is a big burden on the academia for them to research and innovate to speed up the development of the African continent to accommodate its rising population, devise appropriate ways of funding university education as well as address the rising socioeconomic challenges in Africa

In a similar vein, the Chairman of AWAU, Prof. Abdullahi Bala, Vice-Chancellor, Federal University of Technology, Minna, in his opening remarks said, "AWAU has since 2013 unfailingly organised annual conferences to deliberate extensively on issues concerning higher education in West Africa. Previous conferences were held in Ouagadougou, Burkina Faso (2013); Cape Coast, Ghana (2014); Abuja, Nigeria (2015); Abidjan, Cote d'Ivore (2016); Niamey, Niger Republic (2017); Dakar, Senegal (2018); and Benin Republic (2019)."

According to him, the 2023 Conference should have been held in 2020, but, "Here we are holding it three years later." The conference, which was scheduled to hold on 15th-17th September, 2020, could not hold because of the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and its attendant disruptions of most activities, including international flights and academic activities.

He called on all participants at the conference to note, "The challenges facing higher education in West Africa, which are numerous, including the perennial problems of massification, inadequate capacity to absorb qualified applicants for higher education, low levels of internationalisation and students' mobility, and inadequate collaboration for cross-border research among institutions in the region."

He urged members to reflect, in their discussion at the conference, the new realities of the post-COVID era and the steps needed to be taken by AWAU in promoting, forging and facilitating unique partnerships and cross-border collaborations towards leveraging on the opportunities available to higher educational institutions and the academic community in general to combat existing and emerging challenges.

Prof. Yakubu Ochefu delivering the keynote address on "Education 4.0 and Reorienting Higher Education in West Africa for National and Regional Development" declared that the conference affords all the opportunity to take a hard and critical look at the triggers for the disruption of the nature and character of higher education in the subregion and how participants can translate these into opportunities as part of efforts to reform and transform the sector.

Furthermore, he stated that globally, the higher education business has been in a state of transformation for the past two decades and disclosed that two major forces have been driving this transformation. He said these were the role of knowledge in the development of contemporary societies and the broader application of information technologies in education delivery. He posited that a significant debate in higher educational discourse is how the university system will confront the challenges and changes occasioned by globalisation.

Goodwill messages were taken from Secretary General, AVCNU, Prof. Yakubu Ochefu; Vice Chancellor, Cape Coast, Ghana; Prof. Johnson Boampong; President, WARIMA, Dr. Kanteh Dembo; the Registrar, JAMB, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, and the Executive Secretary, NUC. In addition, where all welcomed the collaboration with other research organisations like WARIMA. They

stressed the need for collaboration between research management and the university leadership as a key to delivering on the deliverables.

The Registrar, Prof. Is-haq Oloyede, urged the universities to do more as the hope of the region lies on the academia adding that this can be supported by peer review. He also submitted that ensuring inter-personal friendship across the ivory towers, among others, would help in the development of the sub-region.

Chairing a session on "Global Perspectives", Prof. Is-haq Oloyede commended the quality of presentation as he uged all to ensure the full adoption of the issues while decrying the low attendence at the conference saying those absent cannot imagine what they are missing. He tasked all to ensure that their colleagues are well-informed of the benefits of coming on Board.

Papers were presented on "Universities: Past, Present and Future Oxford University, UK"; Partnerships, Collaborations and Inter-University linkages" as well as "Entrepreneurship and Enterprise Development."

A session was dedicated to "University Research and Development" and was chaired by Prof. Labode Popoola; "Setting up a Research Management Office" chaired by Dr. Denbo; while "Research and Development as Catalyst for Change" was chaired by Prof. Nana Oye Akuffor, from the University of Ghana.

Presentation of papers were also made on "Bridging the Gap between Research and Project: The Role of Implementation of Science /Research"; "Underutilized Tropical Seeds: Vital Source of Wealth and Nutricosmeceutics for Sustainable Health and Greener Environment" and "Establishing Research Management Office (RMO) - Catalyst for Institutional Research Development," among others. A manor highlight of the conference was the election of new Executives to pilot the affairs of the Association. Thus, Prof. Johnson Boampong, Vice- Chancellor, University of Cape Coast, was elected the Chairman; The Vice Chancellor of the University of The Gambia, Prof. Herbert Robinson is the Vice-Chairman for the Anglophone countries; Prof. Abdulwahab

# 2023 UTME/DE REGISTRATION: THERE IS REMARKABLE IMPROVEMENT IN THE PROCESS - Adebiyi

he Abia State Coordinator, Mr. Johnson Adebiyi, has described the ongoing 2023 UTME/DE registration in the State as one of the best in a series. He expressed this view during the virtual meeting he held with the Proprietors of CBT Centres in the State recently.

According to the State Coordinator, the virtual meeting, which had in attendance all the CBT Centres in the State, was organised to review the ongoing 2023 UTME/DE registration exercise as well as disseminate vital information emanating from the Board's National Headquarters, Abuja, to the participants.

He stated that based on feedbacks from the monitoring exercise being conducted by the State Office, the ongoing 2023 UTME registration had been seamless and was marked with considerable improvement. This position was corroborated by the Centre Proprietors when they unanimously agreed during the meeting that the registration process had so far been hitch free.

Mr. Adebiyi used the opportunity afforded by the meeting to inform the attedees that candidates, who bought the wrong ePINs can change same at the centre where such was procured by simply paying the difference in price.

He also advised the centres to update their records of the reading texts they collected from the State Office on the Stock Management platform to enable the Board make informed decisions.

Mr. Adebiyi also stated that CBT centres in the State had resolved to assist candidates without Android phones to help them scan the QR Barcode during registration to enable them access the eBrochure and eSyllabus. He, however, decried the reported cases of request for commission by some CBT centres from ePIN vendors and urged them to desist from this act.

# **ALL PERSONNEL FOR UTME TO SIGN UNDERTAKING - JAMB**

s part of its quality assurance measures aimed at enhancing the credibility of its examination, the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) has informed all its personnel participating in the conduct of the 2023 UTME that they had to sign an

undertaking for good conduct before they would be assigned any role before, during and after the examination.

In statement made available to JAMBulletin, the Board listed those personnel to include permanent staff, adhoc staff, service providers, CBT Centres,

other partners, candidates before completing their registration.

According to the statement, the advisory is designed to guard against any infraction during the conduct of the examination as well as make them accountable for all responsibilities

assigned to them in the course of their engagement with the Board.

The Board reminded its personnel of the consequences of non-adherence to this advisory as any infraction on the rules of engagement would not be taken with levity.

With regard to candidates, the statement added, "Candidates involved in any unwholesome practice during the examination might be barred from sitting the UTME for up to three years in addition to publishing their names in some national newspapers as well as circulating

same to other public examination bodies. Culprits might also be handed to the EFCC, ICPC or the Nigeria Police for prosecution to serve as deterrent to others."

# OGUN STATE COORDINATOR MEETS CBT OWNERS, WARNS AGAINST SHARP PRACTICES

## ...Sets Up 5-Man Committee

n his bid to ensure a seamless registration exercise, the Ogun State Coordinator, Mr. Hakeem AbdulHameed, has warned

accredited CBT centres in the State to shun acts that could jeopardise the ongoing 2023 UTME registration exercise.

The State Coordinator, who stated this at a meeting with Centre Proprietors over the weekend, stated that the meeting was a follow-up to the earlier one held by the Registrar with all critical stakeholders in the build-up to the sale of 2023 UTME application documents.

Mr. AbdulHameed advised CBT Centre Administrators to adhere to all the guidelines enunciated in the various advisories issued by the Board.

He reiterated that the Registrar, Prof. Ishaq Oloyede, frowns at all acts that could truncate the smooth conduct of the 2023 UTME. He congratulated the invited centres on their good fortune for scaling the hurdle of accreditation.

The State Coordinator also warned the CBT centres not to register any candidate once they have exhausted their stock of reading texts. He stated that all reading texts to be issued to candidates must have the QR code at the back, stating that on no account should a candidate be given a reading text without the QR code as it is the code that will allow the candidates to access the eBrochure and eSyllabus.

He also informed the centres not to extort money from candidates or warehouse reading texts. He said the remaining texts must be returned to the State Office immediately after registration.

In his response, the Centre Administrator, Eagle Hand CBT Centre, Mowe, commended the

Coordinator for meeting the centres to properly brief them on the dos and don'ts of the registration exercise. He pledged the support of all the CBT centres in the State towards ensuring a seamless registration devoid of any sharp practices.

Meanwhile, the State Coordinator, had, at his monthly meeting with staff of the State Office, set up a 5-man committee to ensure that all logistics needed for the exercise was in place before the commencement of the registration exercise.

The committee comprised Mrs. Folasade Agbonifor, Head, PTC/PRC, Mr. Akindele Dada, Mr. Olayemi Alabi, Mr. Mohammed Ejiwumi, Mrs. Monsurat Ajiboye and Mr. Omoniyi.

The Head, CBT Support Services, Mr. Wale Afolabi, also briefed staff about the outcome of the last accreditation exercise which was conducted in December, 2022. He disclosed that a total of twenty-one CBT centres met the requirements during the exercise. He also noted that out of the nine centres in Abeokuta, only two were accredited which implies more work for the JAMB Professional Registration Centre.

# **FEW FACTS ABOUT JAMB**

- The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) was established for the general control of the conduct of matriculation examinations for admissions into all universities, polytechnics, monotechnics, colleges of education and (recently added) Innovation Enterprise Institutes (IEIs).
- Section 5 (2)of the ACT establishing the Board provided as stated: For the avoidance of doubt, the Board shall be responsible for determining matriculation requirements and conducting examinations leading to undergraduate admissions and also for admissions to National Diploma and the Nigerian Certificate in Education courses, but shall not be responsible for examinations or any other selective process for postgraduate courses and any other courses offered by the tertiary institutions. In the implementation of this section, there is always a synergy with the National Universities Commission(NUC), the National Board for Technical Education(NBTE) and the National Commission for Colleges of Education(NCCE) with the endorsement of the National Council on Education(NCE).
- In exercising this power, the Board is always guided by admission guidelines approved by the Policy Meeting under the Chairmanship of the Hon. Minister of Education with all Heads of Tertiary Institutions and other stakeholders in attendance.
- Since the inception of the Interim Joint Matriculation Board Examination (IJMBE), JAMB appoints moderators for all its questions as well as the grading of candidates scores. It has always done this without failing to still accommodate 'HSC' within the current 6-3-3-4 system. The National Council on Education(NCE) guidelines for the Joint Universities Preliminary Examinations Board (JUPEB) also endorsed the practice for JUPEB.
- The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board shall continue to operate within its laws.

The platform aims to automate the request, review, approval and publishing process for new Programs and Institutions.

A single, simple automated platform provides benefits including increased productivity, improve Audit readiness, decrease in errors, and an improved standardized overall process.

# ADVISORY ON MANAGING PROGRAMMES AND INSTITUTIONS FOR REGULATORY BODIES

#### PROCEDURE FOR ADDING NEW INSTITUTIONS

- 1. The Regulatory Body Admin logs into the system and uses the New Institution form to upload a new Institution.
- 2. The form will prompt for the entry of all relevant institution details as well as approval/accreditation attachments.
- 3. Programmes offered at the new institution may also be uploaded during the creation process.
- 4. All new Institutions uploaded will automatically be forwarded to the JAMB Administrative team to review and publish into the system.

#### PROCEDURE FOR ADDING NEW OR DELISTING PROGRAMMES

- For existing institutions, the Regulatory Body Admin would sign into the system, search
  for an Institution and use the corresponding New Programme form to upload a new
  Programme.
- 2. All new Programme uploads must be accompanied with a scan of the Letter or Approval.
- 3. Additionally, existing Programmes can be delisted from this system. This process also requires an Approval document to be submitted along with the request.
- 4. All Programme changes including new Programmes and delisting would be automatically forwarded to the JAMB Administrative team to review and publish.

5. Regulatory users are also able to approve Programme Delist requests from Institutions under regulation. The Institution would select a Programme for delisting and the request is automatically forwarded to the Regulator for approval. The Regulator would login and under a list of Pending Approvals would review an individual request and provide necessary approval. A request may also be declined, in which case the regulatory user is prompted for an explanation, which is included in the feedback to the Institution.

#### PROCEDURE FOR MANAGING OTHER REGULATORY USER ACCOUNTS

- 1. The Regulatory Body Admin logs into the system and reviews the list of Regulatory Body users within its purview. E.g. NBTE admin can only view other NBTE users. The Regulatory user with administrative privileges is able to create a new user account and restrict to certain Institution categories as required.
- This process takes immediate effect and the newly created user is able to log into the system. Newly created users are STRONGLY advised to change their password immediately upon first login.

#### PROCEDURE FOR USING INTERNAL MAIL COMMUNICATION TOOL

- 1. The Regulatory Body Admin logs into the system and selects the Mail menu which displays the Inbox, showing new and existing messages.
- 2. The user selects the Compose Message form and indicates the recipients which include the following options:
- 3. All Institutions under regulation
  - a. Specific Institution(s)
  - b. JAMB
- 4. The user completes the intended message and may also include an attachment.
- 5. The message is immediately sent to the chosen recipients who are also notified of the new communication.

# ADVISORY ON MANAGING PROGRAMMES FOR TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS

#### PROCEDURE FOR ADDING NEW PROGRAMMES

- 1. All New Programmes are uploaded by the Regulatory Body on behalf on the Institution.
- 2. The relevant teams from the Institution would provide all Programme details and additional information to their Regulator, and in turn the Regulatory user would proceed to upload the Programme details and approval letter attachment into the system.
- 3. Once the new Programme details are submitted, it is automatically forwarded to the JAMB Administrative team to review and publish into the system.

#### PROCEDURE FOR UPDATING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. The DAP user profile logs into the system to view all existing Programmes in their Institution and affiliated Institutions.



- 2. A Programme from the list is selected for modification. The DE Requirements, UTME Requirements or UTME Subjects may be edited and an additional note may be included to provide further clarity. All changes must be accompanied by an attachment showing the approval by the Institution's Senate/Governing Board.
- 3. The changes will be forwarded to the head of the institution (VC, Provost, Head, Rector) for Approval.
- 4. Once approved it will be forwarded to the JAMB Administrative team for final review and publishing.

#### PROCEDURE FOR DELISTING AN EXISTING PROGRAMME

- 1. The DAP user profile logs into the system and selects a specific Programme for delisting. All Delist requests must be accompanied by an attachment showing the approval by the Institution's Senate/Governing Board.
- 2. The request is automatically forwarded to the head of the institution (VC, Provost, Head, Rector) for Approval.
- 3. Once approved it will be forwarded to the relevant Regulatory Body (NUC or NCCE or NBTE) for review and approval. The request may also be declined in case there is an error and the Regulatory user is prompted to provide a reason for declining the request.
- 4. If Approved by the Regulatory body the request is automatically forwarded to JAMB Administrative team for publishing (Programme is removed from the system).

#### PROCEDURE FOR MANAGING INSTITUTION USER ACCOUNTS

- 1. The Institution head user logs into the system and reviews the list of users in the Institution. The list is strictly limited to the current Institution and no Institution can view or interact with users from another Institution. The user with administrative privileges is able to create a new user account and configure the rights and privileges as required.
- 2. This process takes immediate effect and the newly created user is able to log into the system. Newly created users are STRONGLY advised to change their password immediately upon first login.

#### PROCEDURE FOR USING INTERNAL MAIL COMMUNICATION TOOL

- 1. The Institution user logs into the system and selects the Mail menu which displays the Inbox, showing new and existing messages.
- 2. The user selects the Compose Message form and indicates the recipients which may include fellow users from the same Institution, their Regulating Body or JAMB.
- 3. The user completes the intended message and may also include an attachment.
- 4. The message is immediately sent to the chosen recipients who are also notified of the new communication.

# ADVISORY ON REVIEWING NEW PROGRAMMES AND INSTITUTIONS FOR JAMB REGISTRAR

#### PROCEDURE FOR REVIEWING NEW PROGRAMMES AND INSTITUTION

- 1. All New Programmes are uploaded by the Regulatory Body on behalf on the Institution.
- 2. The JAMB Registrar logs into the system to view a list of pending reviews and requests of new Institutions and Programmes. Each request from the Regulatory Bodies may be reviewed individually and subsequently enabled for Publishing.
- 3. Once this action is complete the JAMB Administrative team would publish the requested update or changes into the system.

#### PROCEDURE FOR APPROVING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS CHANGES

- 1. The JAMB Registrar logs into the system to view a list of pending Programme Admission Requirement changes that need approval.
- 2. Once an Admission Requirement Change is reviewed it may be enabled for Publishing.
- 3. Once this action is complete, the JAMB Administrative team would publish the requested update or changes into the system.

#### PROCEDURE FOR MANAGING SYSTEM USERS

- The JAMB Registrar logs into the system and reviews the list of users in the system. The list
  is unrestricted and includes users across JAMB, all Institutions and all Regulatory bodies.
  The Registrar has administrative privileges to create a new user account in any category
  and configure the rights and privileges as required.
- 2. This process takes immediate effect and the newly created user is able to log into the system. Newly created users are STRONGLY advised to change their password immediately upon first login.

# ADVISORY ON PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING OF INDEMNITY FORMS FOR AFFILIATED INSTITUTIONS

# Please find below an updated procedure for processing of indemnity forms for affiliated institutions

- © Candidate goes to any JAMB office to complete his/her application and submit the form after completion online.
- The candidate prints the completed application carrying the indemnity and submits the physical form to the Head of the affiliated institution for signature.
- The Head of Affiliated-Institution proposes the candidate online to the Mother-Institution.
- The Mother-Institution (wherever it is based) logs into the JAMB portal and recommends (or rejects) the candidate to JAMB State office (wherever the affiliated Institution is based) for approval processing.
- The affiliated institution logs into JAMB portal, views recommended candidate(s) and submits the indemnified physical form of only recommended candidates by mother-institution to the State Coordinator of JAMB for upload of physical forms (forms of candidates not recommended online by mother-institution cannot be uploaded). No submission by proxy.
- The physical form of recommended candidate(s) is/are uploaded from the State affiliated-institution JAMB Office to the Headquarters and made available on the efacility platform for processing.
- If the application is approved/rejected, the candidate (and the two institutions can view it) is notified through his/her email.
- The candidate can thereafter print his/her admission letter and access other services online from his/her profile.

# ADVISORY ON PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING OF (DEGREE) ADMISSION AFFILIATED-INSTITUTIONS

# Please find below an updated procedure for processing of admission for affiliated institutions:

- Head of the affiliated-institution logs into JAMB (CAPS) portal and download candidates for a particular programme;
- The Head of the Affiliated-Institution (wherever it is based) logs into JAMB (CAPS) portal and set admissions criteria for every programme such as minimum scores for UTME, post UTME, aggregate, catchment and ELDS;
- The Head of the affiliated institution proposes the qualified candidates for each programme on CAPS and it goes to the Head of the mother-institution;
- The Head of the Mother-Institution (wherever it is based) logs into the JAMB (CAPS) portal and recommends the candidate to the Registrar of JAMB (or representative) for approval or decline the proposal with a reason for the rejection;
- The Registrar of JAMB (or representative) approves the recommendation(s) from the Head of the Mother-Institution or decline the recommendation with a reason for the rejection;
- If the recommendation is approved, the candidate is notified through his/her email and SMS to either accept or reject the offer of admission. The two institutions can log in and view the status of the recommended candidates;
- (If the candidate accepts the offer of admission, he/she can thereafter print his/her admission letter and access other services online from his/her profile.

**NOTE:** The Head of Affiliated-Institution has access to **VIEW ONLY** all recommendations by the Head of Mother-Institution

# ADVISORY ON PROCEDURE FOR INTERNAL TRANSFER OF CANDIDATES FROM ONE PROGRAMME TO ANOTHER ON CAPS

- Mean The Head of Affiliated-Institution proposes to candidate on CAPS to move him/her to another programme;
- Candidate accepts or rejects the proposal;
- If the candidate accepts, his/her records moves to the new programme and the Head of the Affiliated-Institution proposes the candidate in the new programme to the Head of the Mother-Institution.
- The Head of the Mother-Institution recommends the candidate(s) to the Registrar of JAMB for approval;
- The Registrar of JAMB (or representative) approves the recommendation(s) from the Head of the Mother-Institution or decline the recommendation with a reason for the rejection;
- If the recommendation is approved, the candidate is notified through his/her email and SMS to either accept or reject the offer of admission. The two institutions can log in and view the status of the recommended candidates;
- If the candidate accepts the offer of admission, he/she can thereafter print his/her admission letter and access other services online from his/her profile

**NOTE**: The Head of Affiliated-Institution has access to **VIEW ONLY** all recommendations by the Head of Mother-Institution

### ADVISORY ON EXTENDING THE SCOPE OF SERVICE FOR CBT CENTRES

Following persistent requests from CBT centres, the Board has approved that some services hitherto, restricted to JAMB Offices, be extended to other approved CBT centres.

- 2. These services being extended to the CBT centres are registrations for:
  - (i) Part-time
  - (ii) **NOUN**
  - (iii) Sandwich
  - (iv) Distance Learning
- 3. The following steps are to be followed by each centre while attending to these category of candidates:
  - a. First create a Profile for the candidate (note that profile creation is free);
  - b. Login to the Candidate's Profile on e-Facility;
  - c. Expand the "Other Registrations" Tab and select the appropriate registration for the candidate;
  - d. Follow the prompts to make the payment of N3,500 application fees online using the candidate's ATM card (do not collect any candidate's card details, let the candidate be the one to enter his/her card details);
  - e. After payment, the centre will proceed to register the candidate on the Registration App platform and print out the Registration Slip.
  - f. For DE candidates of 2017 onwards, after registration, only the Registration Slip is to be given to them as the candidate's registration information goes straight to CAPS;
  - g. For candidates of year 2016 and before, after registration, the centre is expected to give them both the Registration Slip and an Indemnity Form;
  - h. The service charge for this type of registration is N700 only and payable directly to the centre.
- 4. Do not write down or copy any vital data of the candidates such as card details, profile code, password etc.
- 5. Recall that like the UTME/DE, the template is to be uploaded while candidates are to go away with the original (hard copy) template.
- 6. CBT centres shall abide by the rules as severe sanctions would be meted out to infractors.

# ADVISORY TO INSTITUTIONS ON HOW TO HANDLE THE CONDONEMENT OF UNDISCLOSED ILLEGAL INSTITUTIONAL ADMISSIONS (CUIIA)

## (ADMISSIONS CONDUCTED OUTSIDE CAPS 2017-2020)

The Board introduced the **Central Admissions Processing System (CAPS)** in 2017 as the transparent platform for all admissions. Regrettably, some of the institutions continued to admit some, indeed large number of candidates (undisclosed to JAMB), thereby jeopardizing the interest of such candidates admitted through under-the table deals.

Recent events made the candidates protest the disadvantages of such non-disclosure and lack of formal recognition of their degrees. Such Institutions are now being compelled by necessity to confess their past deeds of undisclosed admission.

This Advisory is to guide the affected institutions on how the candidates can be rescued:

- I. The institutions should first and foremost declare the number of candidates admitted outside CAPS by sending a formal letter of confession and disclosure (LCD) to the Registrar of JAMB.
- ii. The letter of confession and disclosure shou<mark>ld have</mark> the list of candidates attached. A copy of the letter and the list of candidates should be sent to JAMB state office where the institution is located. The list and total number of affected candidates for each year of admission should be clearly specified with the Programme (i.e Course of Study).
- iii. If the Board upon receiving the letter (and after due scrutiny and investigations) grants approval, the institution shall be contacted within 2 weeks of acknowledged receipt of the LCD.
- iv. The portal is then opened for the Institution to upload the list of candidates already submitted.
- v. The letter of approval from JAMB to the institution and the uploaded list shall contain the following:
  - the academic year for which the retroactive approval is granted;
  - total number of candidates, and
  - the period of grace (not exceeding 60 days) within which the affected candidates must complete the process of Condonement of Undisclosed Illegal Institutional Admission (CUIIA). Only the candidates declared by the institutions are to visit JAMB office and complete the appropriate form online after paying the prescribed fee (i.e) the application fee of N4,000 only is paid by those without JAMB Registration number for the year and N5,000 penalty paid by every candidate involved.
- vi. The records of the candidates shall then be made available on CAPS after they have completed the online process.
- vii. The Admission Officer of the Institution shall retroactively propose formally the candidates to the Head of Institution who in turn shall recommend the candidates within the specified time.
- viii. The JAMB Desk officer too, shall retroactively approve the candidates on CAPS within the original list submitted by the institution. After approval, the previously illegal students will be able to print their JAMB admission letters from e-facility on JAMB Portal.
- ix. It should be noted that the admission letter would henceforth carry the date of the retroactive approval and not backdated to protect the Board's integrity of the data it might have provided before the condonement. The admission letter would also be named "Retroactive Letter of Admission" to reflect the correct history of the admission.
- x. Please **NOTE** that only candidates on the list declared by the institutions shall be attended to at the JAMB office. The Board shall not extend the period of grace granted to each institution. Any candidate that does not complete the process within the allotted (maximum two months) grace period loses the remedial opportunity.

## **CESSATION OF ILLEGAL/IRREGULAR ADMISSIONS**

- All applications of admissions to First Degree, National Diploma, National Innovation Diploma and the Nigeria Certificate in Education into Full-Time, Distance Learning, Part-Time, Outreach, Sandwich, etc., must be processed ONLY through the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB).
- No Institution should advertise or sell "application forms" for admissions into the programmes. Institutions should advertise candidates to apply to them through Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB). Duplication of application forms is **NOT** allowed.
- Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) and the three (3) Regulatory Agencies (National Universities Commission (NUC), National Board for Technical Education (NBTE) and National Commission for Colleges of Education (NCCE) will ensure that all Tertiary Institutions comply with this policy directive. Other Professional Regulatory Agencies will also play a role in sanitizing the process.
- The duration of all Non-Full Time Studies must be maintained as approved by the Regulatory Agencies. This is generally not less than one hundred and fifty percent (150%) of the equivalence of Full Time.

### **ADVERTORIALS**

- Institutions that desire to place advertisement can do so with the requirement that candidates who sat for the current **UTME** (or **DE** candidates) should change to their institutions as First (1st) Choice rather than requesting the candidates to purchase another application form or apply. This is to prevent the issue of double registration which is a violation of the mandate of JAMB.
- It should be reiterated that no Institution should advertise or sell "application forms" for admissions into the programmes listed above. Institutions should advise candidates to apply to them through Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB). Duplication of application forms is **NOT** allowed.
